

**Horsin' Around Expo & Battle of the Bulls 2010**  
**Extreme Cowboy Race Rules**

1. The Extreme Cowboy Race is a sanctioned race by **EXCA** (Extreme Cowboy Race Association), which has been developed by Craig Cameron.
2. All rules for the Expo's Extreme Cowboy Race will be in compliance with the rules set by **EXCA**. Please visit [www.extremecowboyassociation.com/rulebook.htm](http://www.extremecowboyassociation.com/rulebook.htm) to read all the rules.
3. Everyone is invited to participate, either as a member of **EXCA** or as a non-member. However, **EXCA** members are the only participants that will accumulate points to apply to their EXCA membership, which allows them to compete with other members in our region and 16 other regions throughout the United States and Canada. 4. The Expo is offering three divisions with entry fees as follows:

	<b><u>Pre Registration*</u></b>	<b><u>Post Registration</u></b>
Pro (18 yrs & older)	\$50	\$55
Non Pro (18 yrs older)	\$35	\$40
Youth (12-17 yr olds)	\$25	\$30

\*Deadline for Pre Registration is **July 1, 2010**.

5. Participant's age is based on their age as of January 1, 2010.
6. **EXCA** members and non-members that are competing in the **Pro Division** will be competing for \$500 with the payout to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places as follows: \$300 to 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$150 to 2<sup>nd</sup> place and \$50 to 3<sup>rd</sup> place. **EXCA** members and non-members that are competing in the Non Pro & Youth Divisions will be competing for prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each division.
7. All awards will be presented at the Awards Ceremony on Sunday. If you cannot be at the Awards Ceremony, you need to notify the secretary to make other arrangements to receive any awards you may have won.
8. Participants may **NOT** practice in the Extreme Trail area at any time. Any rider found practicing in the Extreme Trail area will be disqualified from the competition.
9. All Horse/rider equipment is rider's discretion, but horse equipment must be humane. Traditional cowboy gear is encouraged. Helmets are highly recommended.
10. All entry forms must be accompanied by a signed release.
11. All protests will be placed in writing and submitted within 30 minutes of the incident, together with a \$50.00 **cash** protest fee. If the protest is sustained or no decision is reached, the money will be returned. If the protest is denied, the money will be retained by the expo. Protests will be heard by five (5) members of the Horsin' Around Expo board. This group will assemble as soon as possible and resolve the protest by the end of day that protest is submitted.
12. **If no protests are filed within the 30 minutes of the incident, all places first, second and third are final. Due to the pressing time schedule, any other contested scores and/or complaints will be assessed and will be used to improve next year's competition. However, the results of this competition are then FINAL!**
13. Changes may be made to these rules up to 30 days prior to the event, but not after.
