

## Horsin' Around Expo & Battle of the Bulls 2010

### Gaming Rules

1. There will be a total of 5 games: Pole Bending, Keyhole, Speed Barrels, Flag Race & Figure 8.
2. There are three divisions: **Pro**  
**Non Pro** – age group 14 & Under  
**Non Pro** – age group 15 & Over.

Participant's age is based on their age as of January 1, 2010.

3. Entry fee for **Gaming** is as follows:

#### Pro Division

Pre Registration	\$40 per rider/horse for all 5 Games (Deadline is July 1, 2010)
Post Registration	\$45 per rider/horse for all 5 Games

#### Non Pro Divisions – age groups 14 & Under and 15 & Over

Pre Registration	\$20 per rider/horse for all 5 Games (Deadline is July 1, 2010)
Post Registration	\$25 per rider/horse for all 5 Games

Or

Pre Registration	\$5 per rider/horse per run (Deadline is July 1, 2010)
Post Registration	\$6 per rider/horse per run

4. The **Pro Division** is running for a **\$500 purse** to the top three places. To qualify, Pro riders must compete in all 5 games. Both **Non Pro Divisions** are running for prizes.
5. Each event is timed. Each contestant with the fastest time in each individual event shall be awarded first place, with all successive times to receive respective placing in order of time run.
6. All other rules will be based on the National Saddle Club Association rules for O-mok-see games.
7. Participants in Battle of the Breeds and/or Ultimate Horse Competition may compete in the Gaming event as a separate entry. They will need to pay the Gaming entry fee in accordance with fee schedule above. If you participate in Battle of the Breeds and/or Ultimate Horse Competition plus gaming, which event you are running for will be determined before each run is ran and that run's time will go towards that event.
8. All Horse/rider equipment is rider's discretion, but horse equipment must be humane. Traditional cowboy gear is encouraged. Helmets are highly recommended.
9. All entry forms must be accompanied by a signed release.
10. All protests will be placed in writing and submitted within 30 minutes of the incident, together with a \$50.00 **cash** protest fee. If the protest is sustained or no decision is reached, the money will be returned. If the protest is denied, the money will be retained by the expo. Protests will be heard by five (5) members of the Horsin' Around Expo board. This group will assemble as soon as possible and resolve the protest by the end of day that protest is submitted.
11. **If no protests are filed within the 30 minutes of the incident, all places first, second and third are final. Due to the pressing time schedule, any other contested scores and/or complaints will be assessed and will be used to improve next year's competition. However, the results of this competition are then FINAL!**
12. Changes may be made to these rules up to 30 days prior to the event, but not after.
